| Action Taken | Prosecution action against Joshua Emerton Pty Ltd for: one offence of failing to ensure that every reasonable precaution was taken to protect children from harm and from any hazard likely to cause injury – section 167(1) of the Children (Education and Care Services) National Law (NSW); and one offence of failing to take reasonable steps to ensure that staff followed policies and procedures – clause 170(1) of the Education and Care Services National Regulations (NSW). |
| Date of conviction | 16 December 2020 |
| Sentence | Convicted at Toronto Local Court and fined a total of \$2,200. Conviction confirmed on appeal to the Newcastle District Court. |

Proven offence:

Joshua Emerton Pty Ltd:

- failed to take reasonable steps to ensure that nominated supervisors and staff members of the service followed the Sun Safety Policy in that the staff:
 - failed to provide adequate sun protection and failed to provide extra sun protection between 11:00am and 3:00pm;
 - o planned outdoor activities to occur in the full sun;
 - o failed to ensure that educators and children were wearing hats;
 - failed to ensure that educators and children were wearing sun safe clothing;
 - failed to ensure that children properly reapplied sunscreen every two hours:
 - o failed to ensure that educators acted as role models and demonstrated sun safe behaviour; and
- failed to ensure that every reasonable precaution was taken to protect children being educated and cared for by the service from harm and from any hazard likely to cause injury in that it:

- o failed to ensure that the activities were conducted in shaded areas;
- o failed to ensure that the child was wearing sufficient sunscreen, sun safe clothing and a hat during the excursion.
