Research says a large percentage of car crashes involve the driver being distracted.



The 3 biggest distractions

for a driver inside a vehicle are:



passengers



mobile devices

loud noise

Young drivers

Have a higher crash risk when travelling with passengers of a similar age than when travelling alone.

Are easily distracted.



Can be negatively or positively influenced by passengers.

As a positive influencer

Respect the driver's:

- licence conditions
- passenger limits for P1 and P2 drivers
- role in driving safely and legally
- Be a responsible passenger by:
 - wearing your seatbelt
 - eliminating mobile phone distractions
 - keeping the noise down
 - adjusting all music devices
 - helping the driver identify hazards, e.g. speed limits, pedestrians, road works



- Be assertive and speak up if the driver:
 - makes you feel unsafe
 - is speeding
 - has been drinking or taking drugs
 - is using a mobile phone
 - is distracted.
